

Two Rivers COG

History

The organization was initially formed in 1990 as the Two Rivers Congress of Governments. In November of 1999 it was reauthorized with a Joint Municipal Agreement of Intergovernmental Cooperation with the name changed to the Two Rivers Council of Governments (TRCOG). At that time the members were the City of Easton; the townships of Palmer, Forks, Williams and Lower Nazareth; and, the boroughs of Wilson, Glendon, and West Easton. Since that time Lower Nazareth has joined the Nazareth Area COG, Glendon has left the COG and Bethlehem Township and Freemansburg have joined the COG.
